I am very pleased to write in support of the above named student from the University of Leeds, who has applied to spend July – September 2013 with you on an elective. He is a registered student of the School and by the time of the elective, will be at the start of the 5<sup>th</sup> year of the course.

Up to the end of the fourth year, the medical course comprises 2 full years of clinical work; junior medicine and surgery (18 weeks in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year) and the required courses (with examinations) in paediatrics and child health (8 weeks), and obstetrics, gynaecology and sexual health (8 weeks). Students will also have covered a 16 week block (with exams) covering Psychiatry, Public Health Medicine, and Primary Care, and a further 16 week block (with exams) in Medical and Surgical Specialities which includes: Cancer, Critical and Continuing Care (this includes rehabilitation medicine, oncology and palliative care, anaesthetics and critical care).

All students receive training and are assessed in Infection Control, use of Personal Protective Equipment, and Basic Life Support as part of the course and students would not be allowed to progress beyond 3<sup>rd</sup> year without satisfactory results in all these topics.

Students in this School are required to undertake a period of elective studies. This can take place anywhere in the world as long as the proposal meets my approval. After the time spent with you, he will be returning to Leeds to complete the final year of the MB ChB course, and is expected to qualify in June 2014.

He has a satisfactory record to date, and I am sure he will benefit from the time spent with you.

I can confirm that Leeds is on the World Health Organisation Register.
